


Ferns & Grasses

Fern - Adiantum (American Maiden Hair)-Native of North America
must be grown in moist, loose soil in considerable shade.

 **pedatum** **mid-green** **2'x18"** **\$11.99**




Fern - Athyrium (Lady Fern)-Finely-textured, mid-green fronds
arch out from crown, stems dark red when mature. Vigorous
grower, but slow to spread.

 **filix femina** **mid-green** **18"x18"** **\$13.99**




Fern - Dennstaedtia (Hay-Scented Fern)-Light, feathery foliage can
tolerate full sun if provided with enough moisture. Pleasant
fragrance for which it is named is most noticeable on hot days.

 **punctilobula** **mid-green** **2'x2'** **\$11.99**




Fern - Onoclea (Sensitive Fern)- Small, moisture-loving fern can
also be grown in full sun. Lime green foliage and interesting
spore cases can be used in floral arrangements.

 **sensibilis** **lime** **1'x1'** **\$11.99**




Fern - Polystichum (Christmas Fern) -One of the most dependable,
undemanding ferns. Forms a medium sized clump of dark
green, leathery fronds which unfurl from attractive silvery
fiddleheads in spring.

 **acrostichoides** **dark green** **3'x2'** **\$11.99**




Grass - Calamagrostis (Karl Foerster Feather Reed) -Beautiful

 cool season grass with an upright habit. Flowers start bright pink to red, fade to buff. Thrives in poor soil.

x. acutiflora **deep green** **5'x2'** **\$17.00**




Grass - Festuca (Blue Fescue) -Spiky foliage forms a rounded clump

 and keeps its color all year.

 wide variety of heights and plumes, some with red colors or spotted leaves. Great winter interest.
